

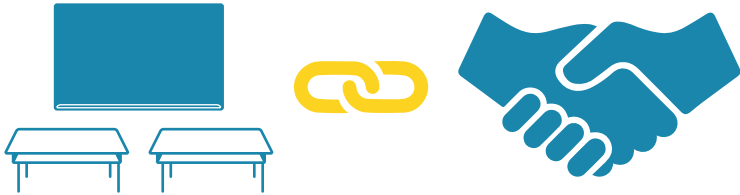


OVERVIEW
