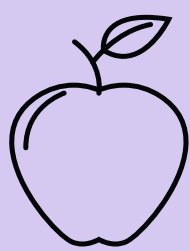

Our Professional Learning Community (PLC) focuses on teacher growth and student learning. PLCs collaborate on instructional best practices, drive new teacher recruitment, schoolwide continuous improvement and accountability for student outcomes that include individualized interventions and extensions

#### Equity:

Our Inclusion and Equity Council seeks to close the achievement and enrollment gap to reflect our school demographics. They collaborate with content teams and teacher to ensure each student finds a high sense of belonging in our school community.

#### LEAD:

Students at Park Hill South High School can choose to take their coursework at the LEAD Innovation Studio. LEAD is a full day academic program which provides course offerings from the same catalog as Park Hill South High School, including Advanced Placement and Dual Credit offerings, but delivers content through a mastery and project based learning approach. In addition, students are paired with a teacher who provides regular 1 to 1 mentoring to support in long and short term goal setting, and in the development of social-emotional skills and habits of success. Students participate in interscholastic activities through Park Hill South High School, but are transported during the day to the LEAD site for their classwork. LEAD students graduate from Park Hill South High School and their GPA and class rank are calculated among their senior peers there
