## AP vs. Dual Credit: Which should I choose?

# AP<sup>®</sup>

- Advanced Placement (AP) courses provide course credits at the college/university level when you receive a qualifying score on the AP exam given in May.
- Colleges determine the minimum score and amount of college credit assigned for the course.
- AP courses received a weighted high school grade.
- There is a cost for the AP exam (currently \$100).

# Dual Credit

- Dual Credit courses provide college credit through local colleges/universities if you meet certain [eligibility requirements](#).
- Dual credits are accepted as transfer credits by colleges/universities. Each college determines the type of credit assigned for the course.
- There is a cost for college credit, per credit hour. Cost is determined by the college.
- **If you have a Dual Credit class second semester, you must have a qualifying ACT or Accuplacer score to be eligible.** [Register for the Accuplacer at PHS in December.](#)

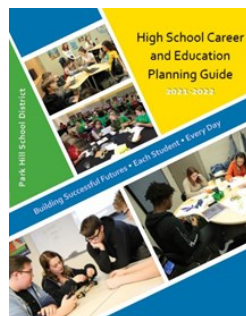
